With the acceptance by the school of your child for enrollment, parents will recognize and accept the following conditions:

1) Adherence to all basic statutes as indicated in the Board of Education Policy Manual and in the Student/Parent Handbook and all mandates as expressed by the Administration of the BAIA.

- 2) Email is the primary method of communication at BAIA. All parents must have a viable email address and to reply to the regular messages that are sent home from the administration and teachers.
- 3) To ensure that family vacations and non-essential trips are scheduled according to the BAIA yearly calendar.
- 4) To ensure that their children attend school punctually and regularly and perform all expected homework and class-room assignments.
- 5) Prompt payment of tuition and related fees as approved and designated by the Board of Education and/or Administration. <u>Tuition payments are due promptly on the assigned dates in August, November, and March.</u> Failure to comply will result in a late fee of 10%.
- 6) To accept academic and disciplinary decisions of the administration.
- 7) To ensure that your children adhere to the school's student dress and behavior codes.
- 8) BAIA have a strict age policy as follows:
 - o A Student must be 4 years old by Sept. 1ST to enter Kinder 1
 - o A Student must be 6 years old by Sept. 1ST to enter first grade
 - o A Student must be 8 years old by Sept. 1ST to enter third grade

The progression follows through all the grades through 12^{TH} Grade

- 9) To have conferences with the teachers and/or administration when requested to do so for the purpose of discussing the student's progress and/or behavior.
- 10) The school does take all reasonable precautions to prevent accidents and the spread of contagious diseases. The school does not accept liability for accidents occurring to students while on school grounds, being transported to and from campus, or participating in school sanctioned activities such as field trips, clubs and after school activities. The school does provide basic accident coverage for students, but the program is not extensive or all-inclusive. Parents should provide additional private insurance. The maximum, which the school's insurance pays is minimal.
- 11) Burundi Ministry of Education registered Burundi American International Academy in April 2017 and then formally accredited BAIA on June 7, 2018. BAIA is accredited by Cognia located in Alpharetta, Georgia, USA.
